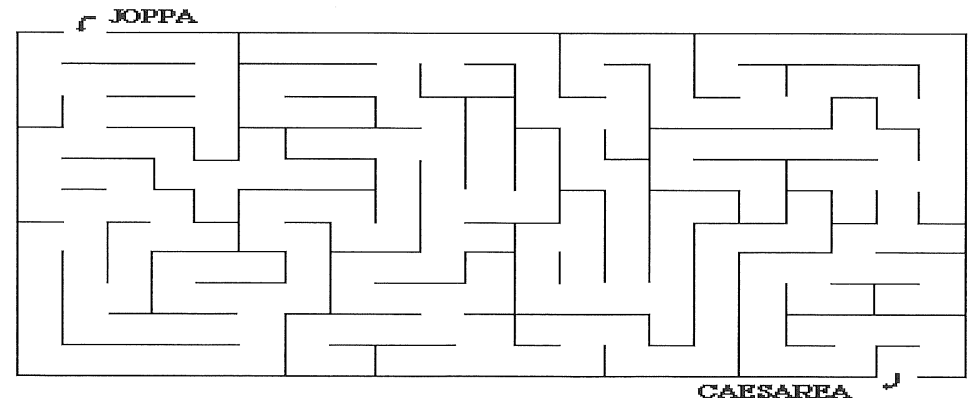

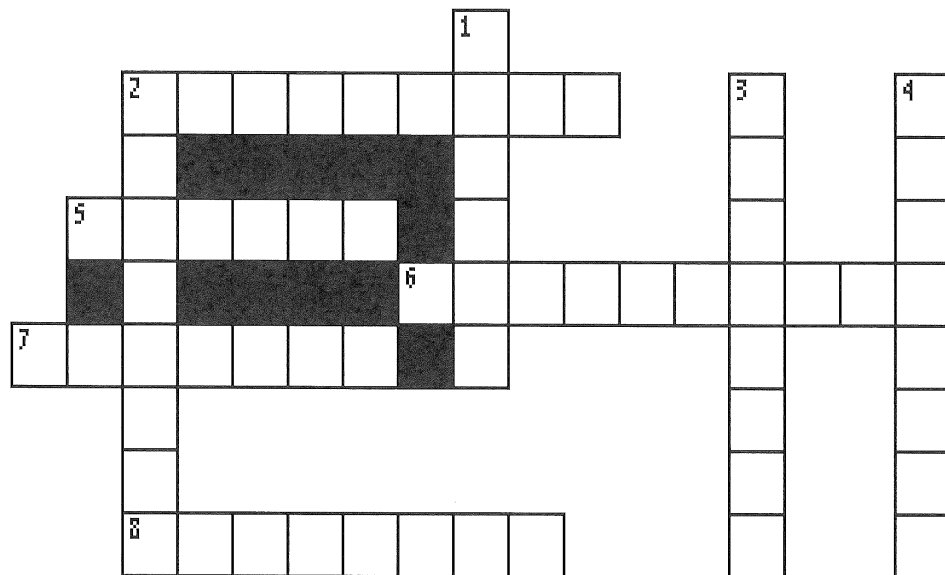

(ACTS 10:1-8, 24-48)



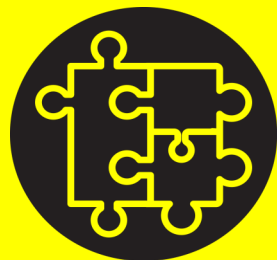
- 2 ACROSS "There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a \_\_\_\_ of what was called the Italian Regiment..." **ACTS 10:1**
