The Ladies of the MMW will collect Bibles and other materials for LOVE PACKAGES.ORG. Clean out your bookshelves and share the Word of God with the world!

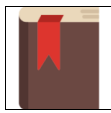

All tracts



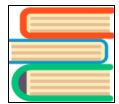
Puppets, Nativity Sets, etc.
