Advent Reading Week Three – JOY

(Light the first two candles again)

Reader 1: We have lit again the first two candles in our Advent wreath, to remind us of God's gifts of hope and peace. Today we will light the third candle, the candle of **joy**.

Reader 2: As we wait for Christmas, the birth of Jesus, we look forward to the joyful celebrations we will share and those we love. The prophet Zephaniah calls us to shout for joy because God will transform the people. When Jesus was born in Bethlehem, the angel told the shepherds not to be afraid. The angels brought "Good news of a great joy, which shall be to all people." The good news of Jesus' birth and the promise of Shalom are still "tidings of great joy" for us today.

Reader 1: We are invited to reflect on the joy we have access to because of our faith in Jesus. One of the defining characteristics of Christ-followers is their joyful demeanor. Let's not allow the struggles of this year steal from the great joy we have because of Jesus.

Reader 2: Philippians 4: 4-6 says, "**Rejoice** in the Lord always. I will say it again: **Rejoice!** Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near." The third candle reminds us of our **joy** in Jesus Christ.

(Light the third candle.)

All pray: God of Joy, thank you for the excitement and delight we experience at this joyful time of year. Help us to share your joy with others, so that they too will be filled with your spirit.

Amen.


