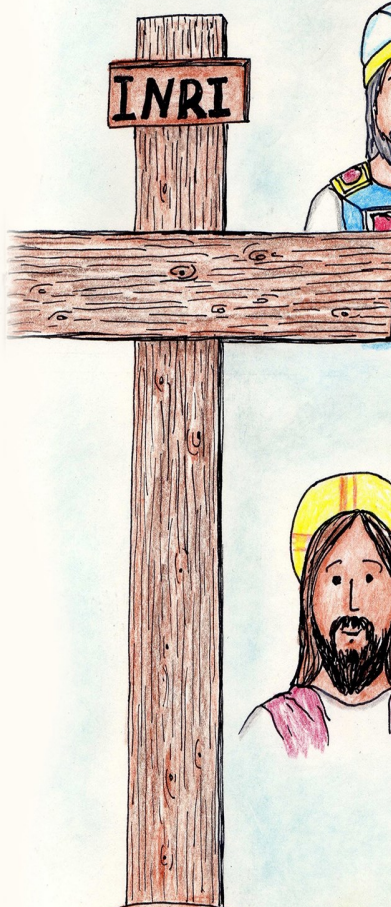

- offers sacrifice for sins (for the people & for himself)
- Does not take the honor of high priest upon himself but is called by GOD (like Aaron).

- + Jesus also was appointed, called by God the Father.
- + He offers sacrifice like Aaron and the Levitical priests
- + His priesthood is eternal like the order of Melchizedek.

Although he was a Son, he learned **OBEDIENCE** through what he suffered.
